1 NASA SEWP VI Overview

NASA SEWP (Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement), pronounced "soup", provides the latest Information Technology, Communication, and Audio-Visual (ITC/AV) solutions and services for all Federal Agencies and their approved contractors. Created in 1993, SEWP I was the first Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) in federal acquisition.

Fair Opportunity

FAR 16.505(b)(1) provides that each contractor shall be given fair opportunity to be considered for each order exceeding \$10,000 and issued under multiple award contracts. The method is at the discretion of the Contracting Officer, who must document the rationale for placement and price of each order. The SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT) is the recommended method and automatically includes the Contract Holders within a selected Group or based on a suggested source.

Scope Confirmation

SEWP processes enable Contract Holders to add new commercial technology and IT services to their contract daily. To confirm that a requirement is within scope, send an overview and bill of materials (BOM) to help@sewp.nasa.gov for review.

4 How to Obtain a Quote

STEP 1

Contact the program team

Reach the Program Manager and Deputy Program Manager by phone or email. See Section 7.

STEP 2

Share the requirement

Provide a statement of work, bill of materials, or scope summary for category alignment.

STEP 3

Use the SEWP QRT

Contracting Officers may issue the request through the SEWP Quote Request Tool.

5 Ordering Process

The internal ordering process of each Agency varies. Forms for Purchase Requests (PR) and Delivery Orders (DO) are defined by the issuing Agency, not the SEWP Program Management Office (PMO).

1

Define the requirement

An end user generates a Purchase Request.

2

Route the PR

The PR and funding data go to the Agency procurement office.

3

Agency issues the DO

Any valid Federal DO form may be used. The PMO does not issue DOs.

4

PMO forwards

The PMO reviews, tracks, and forwards the DO to EIT.

5

EIT performs

EIT confirms receipt and begins delivery. Modifications route through the PMO.

Agency-specific policies

Issuing Agency Contracting Officers (COs/KOs) are responsible for awareness of Agency-specific policies regarding orders placed via an existing contract vehicle or GWAC. There are no requirements under the SEWP Contracts for issuing Agencies to use other intermediary procurement offices, except as directed by internal policy.

6 Order and Post-Delivery Support

POST-DELIVERY

Installation and warranty

Policy and procedural information for installation, warranty, technical support, and software support.

ORDER ISSUES

Troubleshooting an order

Status research, coordination with the SEWP PMO, and resolution updates.

MODIFICATIONS

Order changes

Changes are coordinated with the issuing Agency and routed through the SEWP PMO.
